Topics will include a New England Gang Overview, Characteristics of the Armed Suspect, Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs, Corrections Management of Gang Members, United Blood Nation, Patron Saints of Mexican Drug Cartels, Establishing a Gang Unit, Basic Hate Groups / Prosecution Strategies, Asian Gangs and Officer Safety.

The cost of the conference will be \$125.00 per person. Early registration will be held on Sunday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010 from 1700 to 1900 hrs.
